Ann Huggins, 91, formerly of Grand Forks, died Tuesday, May 31, 1994, at the home of her granddaughter in Columbus, Mo.

Ann Svehla was born Dec. 25, 1902, in Czechoslovakia, the daughter of Matthew and Anna (Branecek) Svehla. She settled with her family in 1903 in Pennsylvania and lived in Chicago, Butte, Mont., and Minot before she moved in 1913 to

Grand Forks, where she graduated from Central High School and attended college. She married William J. Huggins Feb. 8, 1922, in Grand Forks. They farmed near Grand Forks until 1943, when he became superintendent of Memorial Park Cemetery. She was secretary of the cemetery from 1949 to 1982 and did volunteer work in nursing homes before she moved to Columbus in February. William Huggins died May 31, 1978.

She is survived by grandchildren, Debi Scott, Columbus, and William B., Los Angeles; four great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren; and sister, Helen Jewell, Bend, Ore.
