Anna Katrin (Simundson) Dippe', 103, of Phoenix, AZ, died on July 3, 2004, in Phoenix, AZ.



She was born November 3, 1900, in Hallson, ND. Her parents were Stephanian and Eirikur Simundson, both of whom were natives of

Iceland. She was the widow of Walter W. Dippe', and is survived by her five children and their families: Dr. Donald W. Dippe', of Anchorage, AK; Dolores E. Ottison, of Phoenix, AZ; Shirley L.
