

## Mrs. C. A. Heen dies at age 89

Mrs. C. A. Heen, 89, Valley Memorial Home and formerly of 110 Reeves Drive, died Sunday at a local hospital.

Mrs. Heen was the widow of C. A. Heen, who served 38 years as clerk of Grand Forks County District Court until his death in 1963. He was succeeded by his daughter, Ruby, who served until 1968. Miss Heen was killed in an auto accident while vacationing in the south.

The former Clara Docken was born July 19, 1882, near Mekinock, N.D. She was married June 30, 1906, at Mekinock. The couple lived in Grafton, N.D. for two years before moving to Grand Forks in 1916. Mr. Heen became assistant Clerk of District Court in 1922 and took over as Clerk of Court in 1925. Miss Heen became assistant Clerk of Court in 1937 and succeeded her father upon his death.

Mrs. Heen was a member of United Lutheran Church, American Lutheran Church Women, Sons of Norway and American Legion Auxiliary.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Henry M. (Lilah) Havig, Grand Forks, and Mrs. Arley R. (Beverly) Williston, N.D.; one son, Warren, Chicago, Ill.; five grandchildren; two brothers, Edwin and Elmer Dokken, Grand Forks and one sister, Mrs. Oscar (Ida) Hensrud, Mekinock, N.D. In addition to her husband and daughter, she was preceded in death by two sons, Roy and Mylo and two children in infancy.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at United Lutheran Church with Rev. Oscar Jordahl officiating. Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.
