Donald W. Dow, 83, 408 S. Fifth St., died Thursday at The United Hospital. Mr. Dow was the president of Grand Forks Welding and Machine Co. and Dow Supply Co.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Norman Funeral Home, Grand Forks, with burial in Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation will be from noon till the time of the services Saturday at the funeral home. Military honors will be presented by the Grand Forks American Legion Post 6.

Mr. Dow was born on Aug. 12, 1895, in Grand Forks. He served with the U.S. Army in Europe during World War I. He operated the Grand Forks Foundry, and was later president of Grand Forks Welding and Machine Co., and the Dow Supply Co., until retiring in 1960. He married Ella Stewart on May 9, 1922, in Mankato, Minn. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Grand Forks, the Elks Lodge 255, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the American Legion.

Survivors include his wife; one son, Donald S., Grand Forks; one daughter, Mrs. Doona Coulter, Annandale, Calif.; three sisters, Mrs. Margaret Dunnell, Sun City, Calif., Mrs. Ruth Anderson, Jamestown, N.D., and Mrs. Lillian Grove, Grand Forks; four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
