

### **Mrs. Gertrude Kenn**

Mrs. Gertrude Kenn, 83, Route 2, East Grand Forks, died Sunday at a local hospital where she had been a patient since April 20.

Mrs. Kenn was the widow of J. D. Kenn.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the First Presbyterian Church in Grand Forks with Rev. Richard E. Zabriskie officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Tuesday evening at the Stennes-Wegner Funeral Home in Grand Forks and Wednesday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mrs. Kenn, the former Gertrude Hoglo, was born Jan. 1, 1887, in Norway. She came to the United States with her late parents when she was eight years old.

Mrs. Kenn married James Drummond Kenn on Nov. 22, 1915, in East Grand Forks. He died in 1956.

They lived and farmed north of East Grand Forks in Grand Forks Township of Polk County, Minn., following their marriage.

Mrs. Kenn was a member of the First Presbyterian Church, and East Grand Forks Red River Chapter No. 226 of the Order of the Eastern Star.

Surviving are three step-brothers, John Hoglo and Bennett Hoglo of East Grand Forks and Tibert Hoglo, Superior, Wis.

One brother, Oscar Hoglo, is deceased.
