George Walsh, 85, Salem, Ore., formerly of Grand Forks, died Sunday, July 23, 1995, in Salem.

George H. Walsh was born March 26, 1910, in Grand Forks, the son of Stuart and Elizabeth (Barlow) Walsh. He was educated in Grand Forks and moved to Oregon in 1946. He worked on several dams in Oregon and was a barber until his 1974 retirement. He married Marion Morton Feb. 10, 1961, in Salem. He was a grandson of George Walsh, founder of UND, and a great-grandson of Thomas H. Walsh, who negotiated for statehood when the Dakotas were territories.

He is survived by his wife; sons, George R. and Ronald, both of Salem, and Douglas, Kuwait; daughter, Elizabeth Wallace, Robertsdale, Ala.; stepdaughters, Anita Rhodes and Nancy Sullivan, both of California; 17 grandchildren; 22 great-grandchildren; and brother, Stuart, Grand Forks.

He was preceded in death by brothers, Donald, Charles and Thomas.
