Gordon Reimer was born on September 9, 1923, in Winnipeg, Manitoba, the son of Martin and Ella (Kittle) Reimer. He moved to Grand Forks with his family, where he attended and graduated from Central High School in 1938. He married Anna Mae Peterson on June 15, 1941. He served in the national guards from 1938-1940 and in the Army during World War II from 1942-1943 with the 173rd Engineers. He received the American Theater Service and the European-African-Middle Eastern Theater service medal. He participated in the Battle of Rome-Arno. Following his discharge, he worked as a carpenter and millwright in the Grand Forks area for 37 years and was a member of the Carpenters Local #2028 for 30 years.

Gordon was active in Boy Scouts Troop #29 and the North Dakota Region AACA Car Club.
