

Miss G. Sand dies at age 93

Guri Sand, 93, a resident of Tuftte Manor, formerly of 1432 Cottonwood St., died Tuesday morning at a local hospital.

She was born Sept. 23, 1880, in Ulvik, Hardanger, Norway. She came with her parents to the U.S. in 1892. They lived in Oakdale Township. She attended rural schools and also school at Emerado, N.D.

Miss Sand began teaching school at the age of 17 in a one room schoolhouse. She later attended the University of North Dakota and received her B.A. and M.A. degree. She also did graduate work at the University of California.

She taught at Minot State College and at Mayville State College for 20 years before her retirement. She then retired after 50 years in the teaching profession.

She is survived by five sisters, Mrs. Bertha Hagert, Grand Forks, Mrs. Marie Ovind, Jamestown, N.D., Mrs. Sarah Stevenson, Mrs. Helen Paulson and Mrs. Hannah Cyrus, all of Medford, Ore.; one brother, Oscar, Truth or Consequences, N.M.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Thursday at United Lutheran Church with Rev. Oscar Jordahl officiating. Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.
