Mrs. Wineman taught English at Central High School before retiring.

Mrs. Wineman was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church and Chancel Guild; a Past Worthy Grand Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star and a member of Acacia Chapter No. 12; a member of Kappa Alpha Theta, Zeta Phi Eta, Alpha Delta Kappa; the National Education Association and the National Retired Teacher's Association.
