## Mrs. John Boe Sr. Services Slated

Mrs. John R. Boe Sr., 76, 623 Fourth Ave. S., died Friday at a local hospital where she had been a patient since Jan. 11.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Monday at the United Lutheran Church with Rev. Oscar A. Jordahl officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state from 3 to 9 p.m. Sunday at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary and Monday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mrs. Boe, the former Helma Tvedt, was born June 27, 1893, at Milan, Minn. She grew up and was educated there. In 1915, she came to Grand Forks.

Mrs. Boe married John R. Boe Sr. on May 10, 1919, in Grand Forks. They celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in 1969.

Mrs. Boe was a member of United Lutheran Church, the Sons of Norway and a past Oracle of Harmony Camp 10738 of the Royal Neighbors of America.

Surviving are her husband; two sons, Rolf, Lakewood, Calif., and John R. Boe Jr., East Grand Forks; three sisters, Miss Inga Tvedt, Montevideo, Minn.; Mrs. Vira Jump, Cincinnati, Ohio, and Mrs. Ida Whitmore, Bremerton, Wash., and six grandchildren.

One son, Pvt. Bernhart Boe, was killed in World War II while serving in the U.S. Army on Guadalcanal.
