

Harry Hoff

Harry J. Hoff, 84, formerly of Grand Forks, died Thursday, Feb. 25, 1993, in Green Bay, Wis., where he had lived since 1991.

Harry J. Hoff was born Feb. 6, 1909, the son of Frank and Alice Hoff, in Walhalla, N.D., where he attended school. He married Vera Bjorback June 29, 1936, in Grand Forks and then served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He worked for and later owned and operated Hoff's Grocery Store, Grand Forks, from 1923 to 1978. Vera Hoff died July 26, 1983.

Survivors are his son, Donald, Green Bay; four grandchildren; one great-grandchild; sister, Essa Hoff, Portland, Ore.; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by brothers, Ed, Alton and Joseph.
