Hazel M. Johnson was born Feb. 24, 1906, on the family farm north of East Grand Forks, the daughter of Bernhart and Caroline Johnson. She moved in 1922 to Grand Forks, where she attended Central High School and Aakers Business College. She married Donald George Wallace Tweton May 30, 1928, in Crookston. He died in 1963. She was credit manager and office manager at Norby's Department Store from 1952 until retiring in 1980. She was the founder and first president of the Grand Forks Chapter of Credit Women's Breakfast Clubs, now known as Credit Professionals. In 1965, she served as district president of the organization. She also was a charter member of the Grand Forks Letter Carriers Auxiliary and was a 50-year member.

Survivors are her sons, D. Jerome, Grand Forks, Dennis D., Seattle; five grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; sisters, Cora Garvin, Grand Forks, Geneva Johnson, Seattle, and brother, Bloyd, Edmunds, Wash.
