

## Harry O. Risk

Funeral services for Harry O. Risk, 71, of Moorhead, Minn., formerly of Grand Forks, who died Wednesday, were held Saturday at Moorhead.

Burial was in Memorial Park Cemetery here.

Mr. Risk was born at Argenta, Ill., July 4, 1899, and moved to Casselton with his family as a child. He was employed by Gamble-Skogmo for 37 years.
