Mrs. L. A. Rulien Dies At Age 71

Mrs. L. A. Rulien, 71, 19 Conklin Ave., president of the L. A. Rulien Agency, insurance and real estate firm here, died Wednesday at a local hospital.

Mrs. Rulien has been hospitalized since Dec. 31.

Funeral arrangements are incomplete.

Mrs. Rulien, the former Hazel Bahn, was born Feb. 4, 1898, in Grand Forks. She moved with her late parents as a child to Russell, N.D. She grew up and attended schools there. She later came to Grand Forks to study music at the former Wesley College, now known as the Wesley Center of Religion.

Mrs. Rulien married L. A. Rulien on April 17, 1918, at Russell. He died April 2, 1954.

They lived at Leeds, N.D., after their marriage and in 1924 came to Grand Forks. Mrs. Rulien continued to operate her husband's business following his death. She was a piano instructor both in Grand Forks and at the Grand Forks Air Force Base.

Mrs. Rulien was a member of The Federated Church, a member and past president of the Womens Guild of the church; a member and Past Worthy Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star and also organist for the Order. She was a member of both the Thursday Music Club and the Thursday Book Club.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Henry M. (Dorothy) Wheeler, Rochester, Minn., and three grandchildren.

One son, Gordon Rulien died in 1959.
