Ira F. "Scotty" Scott, 91, Long Beach, Calif., formerly of Grand Forks, died Friday, April 26, 2002 in Long Beach.

Ira Frederick Scott was born Feb. 17, 1911, the son of Albertus and Emily (Basler) Scott, in Grand Forks, where he graduated from high

school and attended UND. He traveled with a swing band. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II. He received the Purple Heart and two Bronze Stars. In 1948, he founded Scott's Music Store, Grand Forks. He owned and operated the store until 1967, when he retired and moved to Long Beach. He married Alpha Gustavson on Aug. 26, 1942, in Portland, Ore. She died July 17, 1994.

He is survived by nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by brothers, Theodore and an infant.
