

Services Set For Mrs. Freeman

Funeral services for Mrs. Julia Freeman, 78, 1015 Cherry St., who died Friday, will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Calvary Lutheran Church with Rev. Nelson F. Preus officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Monday evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary, and Tuesday at the church for one hour before the service.

Mrs. Freeman, the former Julia Hagen, was born at East Grand Forks, Minn., on Oct. 12, 1891, and educated in rural schools. She married William E. Freeman on Nov. 21, 1927, at East Grand Forks.

The couple had been Greater Grand Forks residents since. Mr. Freeman had been a city councilman until his death on March 3, 1970.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Arthur (Ruth) Moe of Michigan, N.D.; three sisters, Mrs. Peter Haugen and Mrs. Ida McLachlan, both of Grand Forks, and Mrs. Joseph Brunberg of Tacoma, Wash., and four grandchildren.
