

## Julius Johnson Service Friday

Julius Johnson, 85, 909 Chestnut St., died Tuesday at a local hospital where he had been a patient since April 11.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the United Lutheran Church with Rev. Erling H. Wold officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Thursday evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary and Friday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mr. Johnson was born Dec. 5, 1884, in Americus Township of Grand Forks County. He was a lifelong county resident.

Mr. Johnson married the former Marie Helgeson on Nov. 20, 1912, at Reynolds, N.D. She died June 18, 1966.

They lived and farmed in Americus Township until 1923. They moved to Grand Forks that year and lived here since. Mr. Johnson was employed by the Grand Forks County Highway Department until retiring.

He was a member of the United Lutheran Church and the Friday Afternoon Group of the church.
