

Keith Mathews Dies At Age 59

Keith Mathews, 59, a resident of Good Samaritan Nursing Center, East Grand Forks and formerly of 1220 Cottonwood St., Grand Forks, died Tuesday evening at a local hospital.

Mr. Mathews had been hospitalized since Feb. 23.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary with Rev. Richard L. Roder of Faith Evangelical Free Church officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Thursday evening at the mortuary and on Friday until the time of services.

Mr. Mathews was born Jan. 8, 1911 at Emerado, N.D. He was educated at schools in Emerado and Mt. Pleasant, Iowa. He was later employed for several years with the Great Northern Railway. He had lived in Grand Forks since 1948.

Mr. Mathews never married.

He had been a resident of the Good Samaritan Nursing Center for the past 2½ years.

Mr. Mathews was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are one brother, J. Clifton Mathews, 1424 Cottonwood St., who is vacationing in Texas and is returning here; one niece and two nephews.
