Leroy A. Barto, 91, Valley Memorial Home-Medical Park, died there Monday, April 8, 1991.

Services will be at 2 p.m. today in the Valley Memorial Home-Medical Park chapel. Visitation will be from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. today in Grand Forks Norman Funeral Home and after 1 p.m. in the nursing home chapel. Leroy Allen Barto was born April 11, 1899, the son of Howard and May Barto, in Fairmont, Minn., where he grew up. He served with the U.S. Army during World War I and World War II and was a letter carrier in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area. He later was disabled and spent many years at the Veteran's Hospital in St. Cloud, Minn. He also lived in care facilities in Fargo, Thief River Falls, Crookston and Fertile, Minn., before he moved to Grand Forks in 1970 to live with a sister. He later moved to Valley Memorial Home-Almonte Avenue before moving to Valley Memorial Home-Medical Park.

Survivors are his sister, Margaret Barto, Grand Forks; and cousins, Marion (Mrs. Gerald) Kylo, Hunter, N.D., and Erma Admas, Brainerd, Minn.
