He taught in North Dakota communities, including Aneta, Milton, Dunseith, St. Thomas and for 11 years in Grand Forks. He retired in 1967. Susie Smith died Aug. 27, 1965. He married Justine Richards in 1969. They lived in Devils Lake. He worked at the Artclare Motel, Devils Lake. Justine Smith died in 1978.
