



LaVonne Avery

The funeral service for LaVonne Avery of 6813 Horseshoe Circle, Fargo, ND, will be on Monday, April 1, 1996, at 2:30 PM in Good News Lutheran Church, Fargo. Visitation will be Sunday, from 5 PM until 8 PM, at the Korsmo Funeral Chapel, Moorhead, MN, with a prayer service at 7 PM.

LaVonne Gail Dahlum was born at Sioux Falls, SD, on April 18, 1946, the daughter of LeVerne and Ina Dahlum. In 1948 the family moved to Grand Forks, ND, where LaVonne grew up and received her education. She graduated from Central high in 1964, and later received a 2 year degree in business administration from UND. LaVonne worked at the North Dakota State Mill and Elevator.

On Sept. 10, 1966, LaVonne was married to Robert Avery at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in East Grand Forks, MN. They made their home in Grand Forks. LaVonne later worked at Barrett Mobile Home Transport, Inc., and at White Mart.

The family moved to Fargo in 1990. LaVonne worked as a secretary for the Fargo Public School System, at Agassiz Middle School.

In January of 1996, LaVonne was diagnosed with cancer. She died at a hospital in Fargo on Thursday, March 28, 1996, at the age of 49.

She is survived by her husband, Robert, Fargo; a daughter, Gail (Jeff) Gibbs, Breckenridge, MN; a son Donald, Fargo, and his fiancée, Jill Sanders; her parents, Ina and LeVerne Dahlum, Moorhead; 2 sisters, Eileen (Mark) Johnson and Tamara (Mark) Krause, both Fargo; and 11 nephews and nieces.
