Lottie Opdahl, 97, Grand Forks, died Saturday, Dec. 17, 1994, at home.

Lottie K. Johnson was born Sept. 22, 1897, in Byske, Vasterbotten, Sweden, the daughter of Anton and Hulda Johnson, and moved with her family to Canada as a child. She married Nels Opdahl Sept. 6, 1913, in Saskatchewan, and they farmed in Oslo and Warren, Minn., until he died in 1939. She moved to Detroit and worked in a defense plant until after the war. She moved in 1944 to Grand Forks, where she worked as a nurses aide at Deaconess Hospital. She worked at the UND Medical School for 10 years before retiring.
