

Louis M. Andos Services Slated

Funeral services for Louis M. Andos, 65, 1402 Walnut St., who died Thursday at Fullerton, Calif., will be held here at 11 a.m. Monday at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary with Rev. Darrell Meyrer of the Grand Forks Assembly of God Church officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

Mr. Andos was a deputy sheriff of Grand Forks County.

The body will lie in state here Sunday afternoon and evening at the mortuary and on Monday until the time of services.

Mr. Andos was born Nov. 7, 1904, in Grand Forks. He grew up and was educated here. Mr. Andos was previously a carpenter with his late father, H. L. Andos, and for the past 10 years had served as deputy sheriff of Grand Forks County.

They had resided at Fullerton for nine months where they had spent the winters during past years.
