

Mabel Barlow Services Slated

Funeral services for Miss Mabel Barlow, 64, 704 Cottonwood St., who died Friday, will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the First Presbyterian Church with Rev. Richard E. Zabriskie officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state after 6 p.m. today at the Adams Funeral Home of Grand Forks and Tuesday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Miss Barlow was born Feb. 26, 1906, in Grand Forks. She was raised here and was a graduate of Grand Forks Central High School. She later attended the University of North Dakota. Miss Barlow had been employed here as an office manager for an oil company and later at an insurance and real estate office. She was active in many Grand Forks women's clubs including the Thursday Music Club and had served for 17 years as historian of the North Dakota Federation of Music Clubs.

She never married.

Miss Barlow was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.
