Louis M. Pic, 82, 906 N. Fifth St., Grand Forks, died Sunday in The United Hospital here.

Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday in St. Michael's Catholic Church, Grand Forks, with burial in Memorial Park Cemetery.

Visitation will be in Grand Forks Norman Funeral Home after 4 p.m. today, with a 7:30 prayer service.

Mr. Pic was born June 6, 1900, near Whitman, N.D., and he attended school in Walsh County. He married Annie Polak Nov. 13, 1923, in Bechyne, N.D. They farmed there until coming to Grand Forks in 1944. That same year he went to Hastings, Neb., where he worked in a munitions

factory. He later returned to Grand Forks, where he was a carpenter. In 1953 he left to work in Duluth, Minn., and Marquette, Mich. He returned to Grand Forks in 1955, where he has since lived. He belonged to the carpenters union and the ZCBI (Bohemian) lodge.

Survivors are his wife; and brother, Theodore, Grand Forks.
