

## Dr. Lloyd S. Ralston

Dr. Lloyd S. Ralston, 78, 828 12th St., East Grand Forks, died Wednesday, July 7, 1993, at home.

Dr. Lloyd S. Ralston was born Oct. 13, 1914, in Crystal, N.D., the son of Frank and Ruth Ralston. He grew up and attended school in Hensel, N.D. He graduated from Mayville (N.D.) State College in 1939 with a bachelor's of arts and

from UND in 1943 with a bachelor of science and his medical degree at the University of Illinois in 1944. He interned at Garfield Park Community Hospital, Chicago, for a year. He served as the captain in the U.S. Army from 1945 to 1947. He was assistant professor of bacteriology and pathology at UND from 1948 to 1950. He married Ruth Blakemore March 9, 1945, in Kankakee, Ill. He completed his residency in internal medicine at Wadsworth General Hospital (UCLA), Los Angeles, from 1950 to 1952. He moved back to North Dakota in 1953 and, since 1966, had practiced as professor of medicine at the UND School of Medicine. He was a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha honorary medical fraternity. He was certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine, December 1955; fellow, American College of Physicians, 1960; fellow, American College of Chest Physicians, 1965; dean director, Northeast Campus UND medical school laureate 1988; and the medical director of the Grand Forks Clinic. He was also a county coroner of Grand Forks and Polk counties for many years.

Survivors are his wife; sons, Richard, Seattle, and Ross, Ames, Iowa; daughters, Martha (Mrs. Steve) Penkhus, Mankato, Minn., Carol Ralston, Grand Forks, and Lynne (Mrs. Mike) Greenwood, Maple Grove, Minn.; five grandchildren; and a sister, Irene (Mrs. Otto) Bernhoff, Fargo.
