Maude Arnason, 93, Grand Forks, N.D. died Tuesday, June 4, 2002 in Valley Memorial Home Eldercare, Grand Forks.

Maude Christine Thorsgard was born January 29, 1909, the daughter of Thorval and Lena (Lund) Thorsgard, in Courtenay, N.D., where she graduated from high school in 1925.

She received a standard certificate of teaching from Valley City Teacher's College. She taught school in Plaza, Bottineau, Bismarck and Grand Forks.

Maude was a member of Calvary Lutheran Church and the PEO Sisterhood.

She married Albert F. Arnason on August 10, 1933, on her family's farm near Courtenay. Dr. Arnason died November of 1968.
