

Mrs. H. Barnes

Funeral services for Mrs. Harrison Barnes, 72, 318 Belmont Road, who died Monday from injuries sustained when struck by a pick-up near her home Sunday night will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at St. Paul's Episcopal Church with Rev. Frederick T. Gillette officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state after 6 p.m. today at the Grand Forks Norman Funeral Home.

Mrs. Barnes, the former Marie Sattler, was born June 12, 1892, at Duluth, Minn. She was educated at St. Mary's of the Woods Girls School at South Bend, Ind.; Visitation School, St. Paul, and the University of North Dakota. She later studied piano and organ here at the former Wesley College and then studied at the Chicago Musical College. Mrs. Barnes was an accomplished concert pianist. She

traveled extensively on concert tours and was accompanist with the Chicago Opera Ballet. She later returned to Grand Forks and served on the music faculty of Wesley College.

Mrs. Barnes was the widow of Harrison C. Barnes, an insurance businessman here, who died June 26, 1961.

Mrs. Barnes was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, St. Paul's Women's Club, a member and past president of the Thursday Music Club; Sigma Alpha Iota and a patroness of Gamma Phi Beta, women's social sorority.

The family prefers that memorials be designated to St. Paul's Episcopal Church.
