Marlo C. Herberg, 61, 407½ N. Fourth St., died Thursday at the U.S. Veterans Administration Hospital at Fargo.

Funeral arrangements are incomplete.

Mr. Herberg was born Jan. 9, 1909, at Halsfad, Minn. He was raised and educated at Halstad and in 1923 came to Grand Forks. Mr. Herberg entered the U.S. Army in 1942 and served overseas in the European Theater. He was discharged in 1945 with the rank of sergeant.

Following his return to Grand

Forks, Mr. Herberg was employed here as an electrician.

He never married.

Mr. Herberg was a member of East Grand Forks American Legion Post 157 and the Electricians Local 1426 of Grand Forks.
