

## Mrs. H. Tisdale Dies At Age 90

Mrs. Harry (Margaret) Tisdale, 90, a resident of Valley Memorial Home, died Tuesday at a local hospital.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at Wesley United Methodist Church with Rev. Cecil F. Miller officiating.

Pallbearers will be five nephews, John Halcrow, Grand Forks and Ray, Don, Gordon and Charles Halcrow of Drayton, N.D., and Dr. David Gregory, Glasgow, Mont., her son-in-law.

Burial will be in Memorial Park cemetery.

The body will lie in state this evening at the Stennes-Wegner Funeral Home in East Grand Forks and Thursday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mrs. Tisdale, the former Margaret Jessie Halcrow, was born Oct. 23, 1879, at Goderich, Ont. She came to North Dakota with her parents and family in the spring of 1881. They settled near Bowesmont, N.D., and in January, 1893 moved into Bowesmont. Her early life there was the subject of a Herald news feature on Nov. 3, 1957.

Mrs. Tisdale married Dr. Harry Tisdale on Dec. 31, 1913. She had been a resident of Valley Memorial Home for the past 1½ years.

Mrs. Tisdale was a member of the Methodist Church in Grand Forks since 1914 and formerly active in church affairs and was a member of Acacia Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star.

Surviving are her husband; one son, Ernest E. Tisdale, Bartlesville, Okla.; one daughter, Mrs. David (Patricia) Gregory, Glasgow, Mont.; two sisters, Mrs. J. B. Cooley, Minot, N.D., and Mrs. J. M. Shingler, at the family home at Bowesmont; seven grandchildren and one great-grandson.

Five sisters and two brothers are deceased.
