

Former Teacher Dies Wednesday

Funeral services for Mrs. Luella York, 81, 711 N. 25th St., who died Wednesday, will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at



Hanson-Anderson Mortuary with Rev. Cecil F. Miller of Wesley United Methodist Church officiating. Pallbearers will be Leigh Trosen, Mrs. York, George Sandal, Paul Trosen, Robert York, Gus Trosen and Frank Kubousek.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state this evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary and on Saturday until the time of services.

Mrs. York, the former Margaret Luella Burris, was born Sept. 25, 1889, at Lynn, Ont., Canada. She came with her late parents in 1894 to the United States and to Ardoch, N.D. She was raised there and attended the Ardoch schools. Mrs. York was a graduate of Mayville, N.D., State College.

She married Robert C. York in 1916 at Ardoch.

They lived at Ardoch following their marriage until 1919, when they moved to Grand Forks. Her husband was field manager here of the former Northern Packing Co. and later owner of York Realty Co. in Grand Forks. Mrs. York was a teacher in Grand Forks County schools for 30 years and had retired in 1964.

Surviving are two sons, Robert and Gordon of Grand Forks; one daughter, Mrs. Bernard (Anna Belle) Trosen, Grand Forks, and 10 grandchildren.

Her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Burris, are deceased.
