Minor "Mike" Perrin, 77, Grand Forks, died Tuesday, Dec. 27, 1994, in Henderson, Nev.

Minor Orris Perrin was born Jan. 1, 1917, in Pine River, Minn., the son of Frank Orville and Maggie Mae (Huffer) Perrin. He attended Grand Forks schools. He moved to California, served in England during World War II and re-
