

Mrs. Mable Tait Services Slated

Funeral services for Mrs. Mable S. Tait, 79, a resident of Valley Memorial Home and formerly of 401 S. Fifth St., who died Thursday, will be held at 2 p.m. Monday at the United Lutheran Church with Rev. Oscar A. Jordahl officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Sunday afternoon and evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary and Monday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mrs. Tait, the former Mable Johnson, was born Dec. 28, 1880, at South Wayne, Wis. She came in the spring of 1899 with members of her family to Alledale Township of Grand Forks County.

Mrs. Tait married Jack C. Tait on June 5, 1919, in Grand Forks. He died Jan. 31, 1951.

They lived in Grand Forks following their marriage. Mrs. Tait had been a resident of Valley Memorial Home for the past three years.

Mrs. Tait was a member of United Lutheran Church, the American Lutheran Church Women of the church, Friday Afternoon Group at the church and Deaconess Hospital Auxiliary.
