

## Mrs. A. Dyr Dahl Dies At Her Home

Mrs. Andrew Dyr Dahl, 69, died unexpectedly Monday at her home, 1012 Walnut St.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at the First Presbyterian Church with Rev. Richard E. Zabriskie officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Wednesday evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary and Thursday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mrs. Dyr Dahl was born May 10, 1901, at Emerson, Man., Canada. Her parents died when she was a child. At the age of 8, she came to Grand Forks to make her home with a sister and her husband, Mr. and Mrs. W. R. Jack. Mrs. Dyr Dahl was a graduate of Grand Forks Central High School and the University of North Dakota. She later taught school at Ojata, N.D., and Hatton, N.D.

Mrs. Dyr Dahl, the former Olive Jack, married Andrew Dyr Dahl on May 8, 1927, in Grand Forks.

Mrs. Dyr Dahl was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.
