Richard E. "R.E." Demmers, 73, 815 N. 39th St., died Sunday, April 25, 1993, in United Hospital.

Richard Demmers was born Aug. 7, 1919, in Aberdeen, S.D., the son of Anton and Alma Demmers. He graduated from Northern State College, Aberdeen, served with the U.S. Army during World War II, taught in McIntosh, S.D., and worked for Mobil Oil Co. in Dickinson, N.D.
