Reinhold Ludtke, 92, formerly of 3300 Cherry St., died Thursday, Aug. 22, 1991, in Hillsboro (N.D.) Hospital.

Services will be at 10 a.m. Monday in United Lutheran Church, Grand Forks. Visitation will be from 4 to 6 p.m. today, with an 8 p.m. Masonic service, in Amundson Funeral Home, Grand Forks, and one hour before services in the church.

Reinhold H. Ludtke was born Jan. 22, 1899, in Wantonwon County, Minn., the son of Julius and Emilia Ludtke. He grew up and attended schools in the Lakota, N.D., area. He married Ruggie Christopherson Aug. 12, 1934, in Larimore, N.D. They lived in Lakota, where he operated a service station. They moved in 1942 to Grand Forks, where he worked for Great Northern Railway. He retired in 1967. He lived in Tulle Manor, Grand Forks, for several years before moving to Hillsboro Nursing Home. He was a member of Malta Lodge 131 AF & AM, Corinthian Chapter 3 Royal Arch Masons, The Brotherhood of Railway Clerks and United Lutheran Church. Ruggie Ludtke died Feb. 4, 1987.

He was preceded in death by two sisters and three brothers.
