

Robert W. Neil Service Pending

Robert W. Neil, 37, 706 S. Fourth St., died in a fire at his home early Saturday morning. The fire was reported out of control when firefighters arrived at the scene about 5 a.m. Saturday.

Funeral arrangements are incomplete with Hanson-Anderson Mortuary in charge.

Mr. Neil was born at Grand Forks May 24, 1933, and remained a resident of the area his entire lifetime.
