

Mrs. Stella Olson Services Slated

Mrs. Stella J. Olson, 80, 1724 Sixth Ave. N., died Thursday evening at a local hospital where she had been a patient since Jan. 2.

Funeral services will be held at 9 a.m. Monday at St. Michael's Catholic Church with Rev. George Wertin officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Sunday afternoon and evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary where a vigil service will be held at 7:30 p.m.

Mrs. Olson, the former Stella Gibson, was born Aug. 10, 1889, in Cass County, Ind. She moved as a child with her late parents, Mr. and Mrs. Clinton Gibson, to Portland, Ore., by wagon train. Her father was wagon master for the trip. Mrs. Olson later went to Wisconsin and then to Devils Lake, N.D. She had lived in Grand Forks since 1930.

Mrs. Olson was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church.
