Thomas H. Hankey, 74, formerly of Grand Forks, died Sunday, March 17, 1991, in his home in La Jolla, Calif.

Services will be at 1 p.m. Friday in the First Presbyterian Church in Grand Forks. Visitation will be from 5 to 8 p.m. Thursday, with a 7:30 p.m. Masonic service, in Amundson Funeral Home, Grand Forks.

Thomas H. Hankey was born April 12, 1916, in Grand Forks, the son of Frank and May Hankey. He attended schools in Grand Forks and later went to UND. He was in the U.S. Army in World War II, and married Ann Thweatt Sept. 28, 1954, in Humboldt, Tenn. They lived in Grand Forks, where he was credit manager and assistant administrator of Deaconess Hospital and The United Hospital. Ann Hankey died July 5, 1979.
