

### **Thorvald Jenson**

Thorvald O. "Fred" Jenson, 81, 919 Cherry St., died Sunday at a local hospital.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary with Rev. Oscar A. Jordahl of the United Lutheran Church officiating.

Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

The body will lie in state Tuesday evening at the mortuary and on Wednesday for one hour before the time of services.

Mr. Jenson retired in September, 1939, as a locomotive engineer with the Great Northern Railway, now the Burlington Northern railroad.

He was born Dec. 29, 1888, at Warren, Minn. He moved as a child with his parents to Reynolds, N.D.

Mr. Jenson married the former Mary H. Serbo on June 2, 1915, in Grand Forks.

He began employment as a fireman with the railroad in September, 1915, in Grand Forks. He was promoted to engineer June 19, 1928, and served in the post until retiring.

Mr. Jenson was a member of the United Lutheran Church, Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and the Great Northern Veterans Association.

Surviving are his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Palmer (Beulah) Reiten, Grand Forks; one sister, Mrs. Roy (Annie) Wick, Grand Forks, and one grandson.
