

Walter Winslow Services Slated

Walter P. Winslow, 86, 312½ DeMers Ave., died Monday at a local hospital where he had been a patient for one day.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m.

Thursday at the First Presbyterian Church with Rev. Richard E. Zabriskie officiating. Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery. The



body will lie in state Wednesday evening at Hanson-Anderson Mortuary where an Odd Fellows Service will be conducted at 9:15 p.m. by members of Banner Lodge No. 4 of the I.O.O.F. and Thursday at the church for one hour before the time of services.

Mr. Winslow was born Dec. 3, 1883, near Arvilla, N.D. He was educated in the Arvilla and Grand Forks schools. He farmed near Northwood, N.D. and was later associated with the Cities Service Oil Co.

Mr. Winslow married the former Jane Samuelson in 1937 at Devils Lake, N.D.

They operated a restaurant at Fisher, Minn., following their marriage and until retiring in 1957. They have lived in Grand Forks since.

Mr. Winslow was a member of the First Presbyterian

Church, Banner Lodge No. 4, I.O.O.F., United Commercial Travelers and the Woodman Lodge.
