

### **Lee services Wednesday**

Services for Dr. Ya Pin Lee, 53, 701 N. 24th St., and a biochemist at the University of North Dakota, will be at 10 a.m. Wednesday at Grand Forks Norman Funeral Home. Burial will be at Memorial Park Cemetery.

Dr. Lee died Saturday night at The United Hospital following a short illness.

Visitation will be after 4 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home.

Dr. Lee was born Oct. 23, 1924, at Taipei, Taiwan. He had received his M.D. from National Taiwan University and a doctorate in medical sciences from Kyushu University in Japan. On Dec. 7, 1950, he was married to Lin Lin Lin at Taiwan. Dr. Lee was a faculty member at Washington University, St. Louis, Mo., and the University of Wisconsin before joining UND in 1963 as a Hill Research professor.

Dr. Lee had been recognized as a national authority on the thyroid hormone. He had worked on several grants made to the medical school at UND. In 1973 Dr. Lee was presented with UND's Sigma Xi Award for excellence in research.

Survivors include his wife; three sons, Andrew, Ames, Iowa, Nicolas, Minneapolis and Benedict, Fargo; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Kan Tsai Lee, Taiwan; three brothers, Ya Ting, Ya Linang and Ya Sang, all of Taiwan; and three sisters, Chou Nei Lan and Chin Mei Lee, Taiwan and Janet Chien, Chicago, Ill.
