

Richard Bratvold Rites Arranged

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in East Grand Forks for Richard A. Bratvold, 26, Rhinehart Dr., who collapsed and died Sunday after helping to push a vehicle from a snowdrift. Rev. A. L. Stenberg will officiate and burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

Pallbearers will be Raymond Murphy, Leroy Brage, Terrance Sannes, James Dudgeon, Ralph Sullivan Jr. and Darrell Bratvold.

The body will lie in state at the Hanson-Anderson Mortuary from 7 to 9 p.m. today and at the church for an hour before the service.
