## Paving The Way To A Better Cemetery

The Grand Forks Cemetery Association (GFCA) is continuing its efforts to improve your cemetery.

In 2020 the GFCA reclaimed approximately one-half mile of old asphalt road and then installed a 3-inch thick layer of new asphalt paving. This process provided for a very solid base for our new roads that should last for many years. In addition, the Association overlayed approximately 600 feet of damaged roads until such time these roads can also be replaced.

The Association's next road earmarked for reclamation and new 3-inch thick asphalt is the main road which runs north and south through the middle of the cemetery. This road is approximately 1020 feet in length and 20 feet wide.

We are grateful for the generous support thus far from so many of our members, their families, and their friends.
